Significant Variances Compared With the Previous Fiscal Year

The National Battlefields Commission had an overall decrease in expenditures of 3% compared to the previous year.

Travel

Public servants: Compared with fiscal year 2014-15, travel expenditures by public servants decreased mainly due to:

A decrease in travel expenses for the promotion of activities and services offered by The National Battlefields Commission particularly the participation of the Development and Marketing Officer at the annual conference of the Voice of Student & Youth Travel in the Toronto region in 2014-15.

Non-public servants: Compared with fiscal year 2014-15, travel expenditures by non-public servants remained constant.

Hospitality

Compared with fiscal year 2014-15, hospitality expenditures increased mainly due to:

- Launch of the new exhibition Battles: 1759-1760 at the Plains of Abraham Museum:
- Hospitality needs to support the activities related to the core mandate.

Conference fees

Compared with fiscal year 2014-15, conference fees expenditures decreased mainly due to:

- In 2014-15, participation in the AATF American Association of Teachers of French conference in the Saguenay area;
- In 2015-16, cancellation of the AQEFLS L'association québécoise des enseignants de français langue seconde convention.
