PRIMARY ACTIVITIES:

- Position 2: variable schedule of 37.5 hours/week from May 1 to June 30, and 20 to 37.5 hours/week (varies) from July 1 to September 2, 2024.
- Position 3: 37.5 hours/week from May 1 to June 30, and 30 hours/week Thursday to Monday from July 1 to September 2, 2024.
- Position 4: 22.5 to 23.5 hours/week Thursday to Sunday from May 1 to September 2, 2024.
- Paid training: 70 hours starting in April.
- Option for days off during summer.
